Within a couple of weeks all Parishioners will receive a mailing from the Annual Appeal. This is the Appeal annual fall mail-out which goes to all catholic parishioners in the Regina Archdiocese. Some of you may have already received a spring mail-out but whether or not you donated to the spring mail-out you will again receive the fall mail –out.



These mail-outs are done by the Annual Appeal Office at the Archdiocese of Regina and Little Flower Parish has nothing to do with the frequency or timing of these mail-outs. All we do is the collect the forms and funds which you return to us and return the forms and funds to the Appeal Office. If you donate to the Appeal by cash or cheque it will be included in your Little Flower 2015 tax receipt. If you donate by credit card or bank debit the receipt will come from the Appeal Office.

What we ask though, is that you return the form that you receive in the next couple of weeks from the Appeal Office to Little Flower Parish by putting it in the collection basket, dropping it in the mailbox or mailing it to us.
